ARRIVAL

- Please arrive no later than 10 minutes before the start of your exam on your day of testing.
- Students who arrive late will not be allowed into the secured testing room once the exam has begun.
- Please leave electronic devices in your vehicle. There are phones at CVA students can use to No electronic devices are allowed in the secured testing rooms.

PICK UP

- Upon sign in, you will be provided with anticipated end times.
- Notifications will also be sent through the CVA Middle and CVA High School ParentSquares. Please ensure you have downloaded this app and updated your notification settings to see information immediately.

FAQ

- Students will have to stay in the testing room until all students are finished with that section of the test. They cannot leave when they complete the test. Allotted times for test completion are different for each subject. The teachers at sign in will tell you the total time and an estimated time of pickup.
- Students do not need to bring anything except a jacket, a bottle of water, and something to read (unrelated to the subject they are taking that day). They will use school devices, pencils, and scratch paper.
- Students are expected to attend their test on the assigned day. Please make arrangements to have your student here on time at the appropriate day for their test.
- All tests will take place at CVA (6000 Columbia Road, Grovetown, GA 30813)
- Parents may wait in their car in the parking lot or they may drop their student off for testing.
